Age Concern has adopted four classes of membership. These are *Individual Member*, *Corporate Member*, *Honorary Life Member* and *Friend*.

Individual and Corporate Membership are approved by the Board of Age Concern Canterbury and such members have voting rights at the Annual General Meeting. Honorary Life Members are elected by special resolution at a General Meeting, on the recommendation of the Board, and also have voting rights.

The classification of Friend offers individuals, firms or corporate bodies the opportunity to assist Age Concern Canterbury in its work to achieve wellbeing, rights, respect and dignity for older people, but Friends do not have voting rights.

Friend \$10.00 per person, \$20.00 per couple per annum
