Individual Memberships are approved by the Board of Age Concern Canterbury and such members have voting rights at the Annual General Meeting. Honorary Life Members are elected by special resolution at a General Meeting, on the recommendation of the Board, and also have voting rights.

The classification of Friend offers individuals the opportunity to assist Age Concern Canterbury in its work to promote the quality of life and wellbeing of older persons in Canterbury, but Friends do not have voting rights.
